

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between the

and

HOLY CROSS OF DAVAO COLLEGE, INC.

The Davis College and the Holy Cross of Davao College, Inc. for the purposes of furthering cooperation in education and academic fields, hereby affirm their intent to explore the establishment of exchange programs and collaborative research/study opportunities.

Cooperation between parties shall be carried out – subject to availability of funds, the approval of both parties, and on the basis of mutual consideration – through a variety of activities and/or programs such as:

- Exchange of academic staff for the purposes of teaching and research
- Exchange/study abroad programs for students
- Participation in joint seminars, lectures, training and academic meetings
- Exchange of research materials in fields of mutual interest
- Research/ consulting contracts
- Exploring potential program collaborations

This Memorandum of Understanding is not a legally binding agreement. It does not commit either institution to any prescribed course of action and shall not require expenditures or other commitments of resources by either institution. If subsequent courses of action are agreed to by both parties a separate agreement outlining terms and conditions will be signed.

This Memorandum of Understanding, subject to revision, renewal or cancellation by mutual consent, becomes effective upon completion of signatures and is valid for an initial period of five years. Either party may terminate this Memorandum of Understanding by giving six months' notice in writing.
